

Coronavirus Outbreak Management Plan (Contingency Plan)

This document should be read in conjunction with Eynsham Pre-School's Coronavirus Risk Assessment and Policy and Procedures, which outlines the day to day management of reducing the spread of Coronavirus and the procedure for a suspected case of Coronavirus. Eynsham Pre-School will report any positive cases of Coronavirus to Oxfordshire County Council and Ofsted.

If we have several confirmed cases within a 10 day period it may be deemed as an outbreak if:

- 5 children, pupils, students or staff, who are likely to have mixed closely, test positive for COVID-19 within a 10-day period; or
- 10% of children, pupils, students or staff who are likely to have mixed closely test positive for COVID-19 within a 10-day period.

Eynsham Pre-School currently have 34 children on roll and 10 staff giving a total of 44. Therefore we will operate our Outbreak Management Plan if there are 4 or more confirmed cases within a 10 day period.

Outbreak Management Plan

1. We will review and reinforce our existing control measures (see policy). This may include, but is not limited to the following:
 1. re-introduction of face coverings for drop off and collection.
 2. re-introduction of a one way system
 3. removal of resources and equipment that cannot be easily cleaned
 4. more frequent, enhanced cleaning of resources and frequently touched surfaces
 5. the use of an external company for a deep cleaners
2. Additional advice will be sought from DfE helpline 800 046 8687, option 1 and Oxfordshire County Council
3. Should there be insufficient staff to care for the number of children, places may be restricted in accordance to our policy.

If there is a local community outbreak, we will follow advice from the local health authority and implement any recommendations.

Any changes or restrictions will be clearly communicated to parents and staff.
